Father Stephen Chow Scholarship for Post-secondary Education 2017-2018

Background and objective

The 'Father Stephen Chow Scholarship for Post-secondary Education' is established in September, 2014 by Mr. Tai Chi Yip and Mr. Tsui Wing Tak, Wahyanites who graduated in 2001. This Scholarship aims to provide encouragement and financial assistance to those promising Wah Yan graduate(s) enrolled in programmes leading to a sub-degree award (including Associate Degrees and Higher Diplomas). The scholarship will be for a maximum of two years and is renewable annually as determined by the Administration Board of Father Stephen Chow Scholarship based on the applicant's family financial condition and his academic progress. It is intended to relieve students of as much financial anxiety throughout their two years of post-secondary education as possible. It is also intended to free them from taking odd-jobs and allow them to concentrate on their studies.

Further details of the scholarship are as follows:-

Name of Award : **Father Stephen Chow Scholarship for Post-secondary Education**

Duration of Award : Up to a maximum of 2 years, renewable annually in the light of family financial conditions and academic progress as determined by the Administration Board of Father Stephen Chow Scholarship.

Value of Award : Either \$10,000 or \$20,000 per student per year. The Administration Board of Father Stephen Chow Scholarship will decide the amount of award for each successful applicant based upon the student's record of service and achievements and the applicant's family financial situation.

Conditions of Award : Successful candidates for the scholarships will be required to comply with the conditions of awards should they decide to accept the award made under this scheme. They include, among other things, provision of reflection reports from time to time and sharings with and guidance of more junior Wahyanites (師弟).

Eligibility : Applicants for the scholarship must fulfil the following criteria:-
(i) be permanent residents of Hong Kong.
(ii) have received at least 3 years of continuous education in Wah Yan College, Hong Kong by the end of this academic year.
(iii) be responsible for fulfilling all applicant procedures and admission requirements at the institution of their choice and subsequently be offered a place.
(iv) be keen to contribute to Wah Yan and society in general upon their graduation.



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- Application** : All applications, including those applying for renewal, should reach the Principal of Wah Yan College, Hong Kong on or before 29th September, 2017.
- Selection Procedure** : Suitable applicants may be invited to attend an interview in October. The decision of the Administration Board of Fr. Stephen Chow Scholarship is final. In no circumstances will the Administration Board be required to explain why any application has not been successful or renewed.

 - v. A copy of your birth certificate or evidence of your permanent residence status in Hong Kong.
 - vi. A copy of your Hong Kong Identity Card.
 - vii. A copy of acceptance letter of the tertiary institution or other proof of enrolment (if available)
 - viii. A copy of prospectus and student handbook of the institution with information on tuition fees and other expenses. (if available).
 - ix. Copies of tax returns of family members, employer's letters, and other documents relevant to assessing the income and assets of the family.
 - x. One recent passport-size photograph which should be affixed securely to this form in the space provided.
4. Deadline for applications is **29th September, 2017**
Late application will not be accepted.
5. Papers and documents submitted with your application form will not be returned.
6. Undocumented or incomplete applications will not be considered.
7. The application summary sheet attached to the application form should also be completed as part of your application.
8. The award of the scholarship is conditional upon the candidate being accepted and taking up a course at an institution or university approved by the Administration Board.



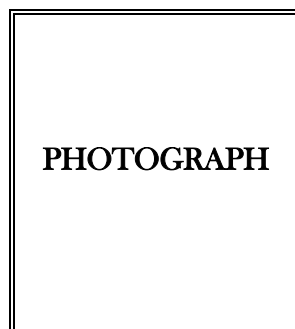
