## **Father Reid Memorial Scholarship for Post-secondary Education 2021-2022**

### **Background and objectives**

The 'Father Reid Memorial Scholarship for Post-secondary Education' was established in September 2013 by Mr. Bernard Tsui, a Wahyanite who graduated in 1982 and continue his tertiary education by receiving a scholarship administrated by Fr. Reid back in 1985. This Scholarship aims to provide financial assistance to those promising Wah Yan student(s) who is / are short of funds to pursue post-secondary education, either locally or abroad. The scholarship will be for a maximum of four years and is renewable annually as determined by the Administration Board of Father Reid Memorial Scholarship based on the applicant's family financial condition and his academic progress. It is intended to relieve students of as much financial anxiety throughout their post-secondary education as possible. It is also intended to free them from taking odd-jobs and allow them to concentrate on their studies.

### **Further details of the scholarship are as follows:**

- Name of Award** : **Father Reid Memorial Scholarship for Post-secondary Education**
- Duration of Award** : Maximum up to 4 years renewable annually in the light of family financial conditions and academic progress. The Administration Board of Father Reid Memorial Scholarship will judge this.
- Value of Award** : The Administration Board of Father Reid Memorial Scholarship will decide the amount of the award for each successful applicant based upon the post-secondary education course composition fee, accommodation and personal expenses either locally or overseas and the applicant's family financial situation.
- Conditions of Award** : Successful candidates for the scholarship will be required to comply with the conditions of awards should they decide to accept any award made under this scheme. In particular, these candidates must return to work in Hong Kong. or other areas in China, or obtain employment with any entity or organization in Hong Kong. for a minimum of 36 consecutive months immediately upon completion of their study programme.
- Permission for a delayed return to Hong Kong to fulfil the employment condition or for waiver of such employment condition may be sought from the Administrative Board. If the candidate fails to get such permission or to comply with the employment condition, he will be required to repay such sum, not exceeding the total value of the award so received, and upon such terms as the Administrative Board deems appropriate.



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- Eligibility** : Applicants for the scholarship must fulfill the following criteria:-
- (i) be permanent residents of Hong Kong.
  - (ii) have received at least 3 years of continuous education in Wah Yan College, Hong Kong by the end of this academic year.
  - (iii) be responsible for fulfilling all application procedures and admission requirements at the institution of their choice and subsequently be offered a place.
  - (iv) be in genuine need of financial assistance. Where, for example, the family can only make some but not a full contribution to the student's further studies.
  - (iv) be keen to contribute to society in Hong Kong upon their graduation.
- Application** : Application forms will be available from July of each year.  
All applications, including those applying for renewal, should reach the principal of Wah Yan College, Hong Kong on or before 24<sup>th</sup> September each year.
- Selection Procedure** : Suitable applicants will be invited to attend an interview in October. The decision of the Administration Board of Fr. Reid Memorial Scholarship is final. In no circumstances will the Administration Board be required to explain why any application has not been successful.

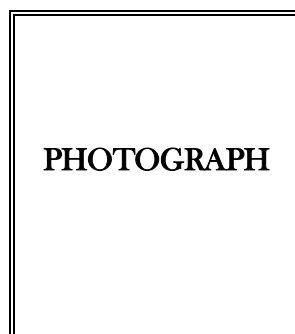

  - viii. A copy of the prospectus and student handbook of the university relating to the course to be taken and information on tuition fees and other expenses. (if available).
  - ix. Copies of tax returns of family members, employer's letters, and other documents relevant to assessing the income and assets of the family.
  - x. One recent passport-size photograph which should be affixed securely to this form in the space provided.
4. Deadline for applications is **24<sup>th</sup> September, 2021**  
Late application will not be accepted.
5. Papers and documents submitted with your application form **will not** be returned.
6. Undocumented or incomplete applications will not be considered.
7. The application summary sheet attached to the application form should also be completed as part of your application.
8. The award of the scholarship is conditional upon the candidate being accepted and taking up a course at an institution or university approved of by the Administration Board of Scholarship.
