1)	16 th June 2023 (Friday)	Deadline for submission of Application Form (Please download from the website.)
2)	21 st June 2023 (Wednesday afternoon)	Entrance Test (for all applicants)
3)	23 rd June 2023 (Friday afternoon)	Additional Entrance Test (For applicants of F.4 places intending to study Physics, Chemistry, and/or Biology)
4)	30 th June 2023 (Friday afternoon)	Interview (For applicants shortlisted after the Entrance Test)
5)	4 th July 2023 (Tuesday)	Registration (for successful applicants)

- 3) Two photographs of the applicant
Please adhere a photograph (1.5" × 2") to the appropriate space on the application form. In addition, attach another photograph by a clip to the form for use in the Entrance Test Admission Form.
