Notes on completion of application form

1. Answers to the questions must be typewritten or written legibly in black ball-pen or black ink.
2. **ALL** parts of this application form must be completed. Where a request for information is not applicable to the circumstances of the applicant, put "N/A" in the blank. Where the answer to a request for information is negative, write "No" in the blank.
3. Completed application forms must be returned to the Principal, Wah Yan College, Hong Kong, 281 Queen's Road East, Hong Kong, together with the following documents:-
 - i. A statement between 500 and 800 words in your own handwriting on the reasons for choosing your preferred area of study and why you consider yourself a suitable candidate for the scholarship (or grant).
 - ii. Recommendation from 2 referees.
 - iii. Copies of your college / school records (Form 1 to Form 6, if available)
 - iv. Copies of HKDSE result slip and the finalized JUPAS choices (for applicants aiming at local studies).
 - v. A copy of your birth certificate or evidence of your permanent residence status in Hong Kong.
 - vi. A copy of your Hong Kong Identity Card.
 - vii. A copy of the acceptance letter of the university (if available)
 - viii. A copy of the prospectus and student handbook of the university relating to the course to be taken and information on tuition fees and other expenses. (if available).
 - ix. Copies of tax returns of family members, employer's letters, and other documents relevant to assessing the income and assets of the family (for grant applicants).
 - x. One recent passport-size photograph which should be affixed securely to this form in the space provided.
4. Deadline for applications is **25th July, 2024**.
Late application will not be accepted.
5. Papers and documents submitted with your application form will not be returned.
6. Undocumented or incomplete applications will not be considered.
7. The application summary sheet attached to the application form should also be completed as part of your application.
8. The award of a scholarship or a grant is conditional upon the candidate being accepted and taking up a course at a university approved of in advance by the Board of Trustees or any other conditions stated by the Interview Board/Board of Trustees in its letter making such an offer.
