7) 27 th Jun 2025 (Friday afternoon)	Interview (For shortlisted applicants after the Entrance Test)

- 1) Copies of **all examination results in the last two years** (if available).
- 2) One **stamped and self-addressed envelope** (DL-sized 110mm x 220 mm).
- 3) Two **Passport photographs of the applicant** (Size 1.5" x 2"), please write down the applicant's full name on the back of each photograph.
- 4) Copy of an applicant's **Hong Kong Identity Card / Birth Certificate / Passport with a valid visa** to allow study in Hong Kong.
- 5) An **entrance examination fee of HK\$50 is made by CASH**. All fees paid are **not refundable and non-transferable** from one examination to another, from one applicant to another, or for any other purposes.

It is required to arrive at the reception on campus at least 20 minutes before the commencement of the first examination on the date of the entrance examination. Being punctual is crucial, and those who arrive late will not be taken into consideration.
