Name a star to give thanks and to help build the Hub of Wah Yan's Learning Experience!



The Wall of Stars is intended to be a permanent display on the wall of the new school hall building that will help to inspire future generations of Wahyanites to become *Men For and With Others*.

5. After whom can I name a star?

Any person, living or deceased, or group, or institution that has contributed to the well being of Wah Yan or members of the Wah Yan community.

6. Can I make more than one nomination?

Yes.

7. Can I nominate jointly with others as a group?

Yes.

8. Can I be an anonymous nominator?

Yes.

9. Can I change the size and design of the star-plates?

No. The star-plates are standardized in size and design as shown and the lengths of your inscriptions are governed by the design grids as shown in the Nomination Form.

10. Is the donation tax deductable?

Yes, tax deduction is applicable in Hong Kong with the receipts we issue.
